PIT PARKING:

Thursday (06/15/2017) at 2:00 PM - Parking lot opens for Pro Watercross athletes

Monday (06/18/2017) at 12:00 PM - All trailers must be out of Spark Marina Park parking lot

EVENT SITE:**Tentative tuning and testing requirements:**

The water is open for athletes with the Nevada Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) decal at 2:00 PM.

All competitor's personal watercrafts will be required to carry the Nevada Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) decal at the cost of \$20 per boat. Decals can be purchased on site on Friday: 1:00 - 4:00 PM & Saturday 11:00 - 12:30 PM at the Gazebo. Do not ride within the race course without a decal. These decals can be purchased online or you can purchase directly from the Nevada Department of Wildlife (NDOW) onsite at Sparks Marina Park. The NDOW will be located at the park's gazebo over the course of the event weekend. If you choose to buy a decal online, you MUST bring the receipt of purchase showing your assigned decal number.

The NDOW will also be on site to perform free-of-charge watercraft aquatic invasive species removal and certify boats. Spark's Parks Dept will be providing a place for the "cleaning rover" at the Sparks Marina Boat Ramp. The service will be available for watercraft entering and when exiting the marina.

The fine for NOT having an AIS decal is \$100 per vessel.

Fuel Station: Fuel must be stored within the fuel area or stored properly in your pit(parking) area - not on the beach. Any fuel in the parking/pit area must be in an enclosed trailer or truck bed under shade. Fire extinguishers are required for anyone with a 55-gallon drum for fuel. - Yellow square designated on the site map.

NOTE: All fuel containers brought into the park must leave with you. Anyone leaving a fuel container will be fined and required to pay all local fines. Security cameras will be monitoring the parking area... you leave it behind, you will be caught.

ATV/UTV RULES:

1. Registered street legal vehicles only on roadways.
2. ATV/UTV speed limit: 5 mph.
3. ATV/UTVs not allowed outside of event beach area, NO HOTEL shuttle
4. You must be at least 16 y/o to operate ATV/UTVs

TENTS: City of Sparks requires that all tents must be securely weighted for this event.

Pre-race Safety Inspection: All watercrafts and racing gear must be checked before competing.

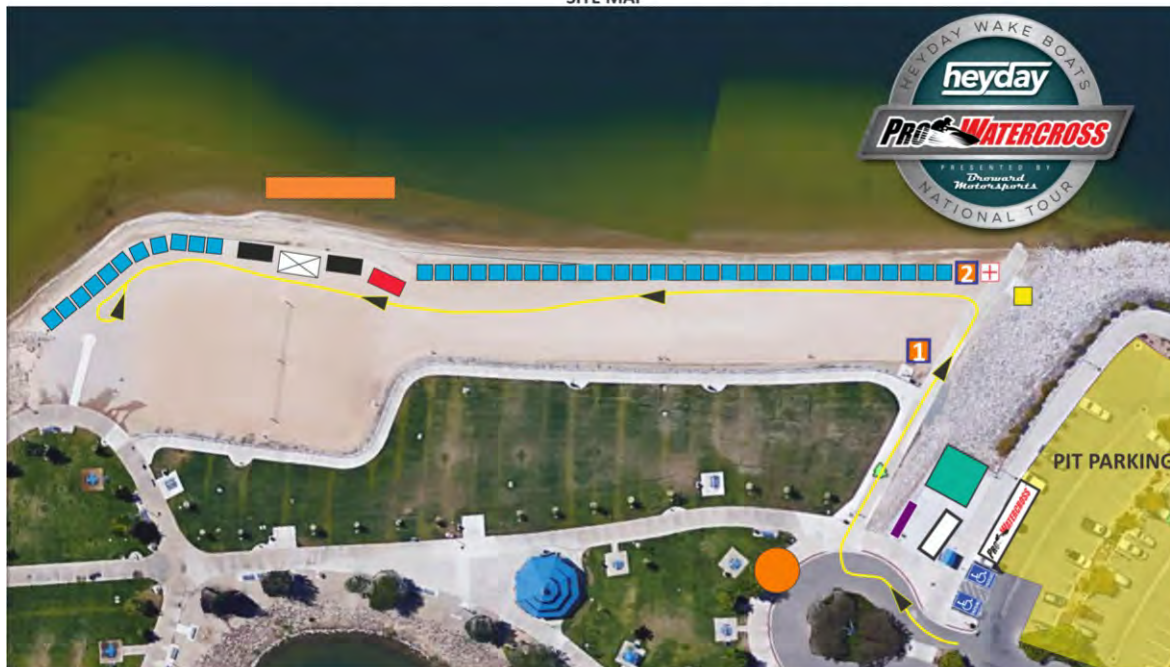
